Locations

The Musselman Triathlon is held at points in and around Geneva, NY. This page gives an overview on many of the locations making up Musselman Weekend.

Seneca Lake State Park | Geneva, NY

Seneca Lake State Park is located in Seneca County, on the border of Ontario County. The park is at the north end of Seneca Lake, and is located between Geneva and Waterloo on Routes 5 & 20. The park has one driving entrance, from Routes 5 & 20. Admission is free to journalists with their media credentials.

Admission & Parking. Parking at the state park costs \$7.00 per car, payable at the admission gate. Accredited media will be admitted to the park free of charge, with proper media outlet identification. Please use caution upon entering the park, as triathletes and vehicles share the same road in parts of the park; obey posted speed limits and law enforcement. Parking is available as space permits.

Lakefront Park | Geneva, NY

Lakefront Park is located in the City of Geneva, in Ontario County. It is adjacent to Seneca Lake State Park, on the west end of the state park, between the state park and the Ramada Geneva Lakefront Hotel. The entrance to Lakefront Park is off Hamilton Street.

Admission & Parking. Admission to Lakefront Park is free, and parking is available as space permits. On Friday this park will be the location for the microMussel and the MusselKids kids race. On Saturday/Sunday this park will be a part of the run course.

Hobart & William Smith Colleges | Geneva, NY

Hobart & William Smith Colleges are together a liberal arts college located in Geneva. Most events at the Colleges take place at the Field House/Sport & Rec Center, located on Hamilton Street (Routes 5 & 20).

Admission & Parking. Most Musselman events at the Colleges take place at the Sport & Recreation Center. This includes registration and the Multisport Expo. Free parking is available in an adjacent lot.

The City of Geneva

The City of Geneva (population 13,617) is located in Ontario County, along the Seneca County border. Geneva is approximately 45 miles from Rochester, Syracuse, and Ithaca. It is 60 miles from Elmira, and 100 miles from Buffalo and Binghamton.

Here's A MusselStory!

Onni Peck, of Fairport, has always been an athlete. Despite being diagnosed with a progressive neuro-muscular disease at an early age, Onni never saw any reason why she couldn't participate in any activity other members of her family were doing. Her parents, Michael and Donna Peck, did everything they could to make it happen.

While in elementary school in Massachusetts, Onni participated in hippotherapy, which is an equestrian form of physical therapy.

"Onni thoroughly enjoyed this," says father Michael. "She was even invited to participate in the Equestrian Special Olympics."

Onni medaled in regionals and was invited to the state-level competition, medaling there as well. After moving back to Rochester, Onni participated in the Empire State Games and other events, until her disease left her unable to continue with the sport.



Michael Peck had been participating in triathlons for several years. Much of his training had been with Onni in tow, including cycling on the Erie Canal with Onni in her Wike bicycle trailer. Over the previous year, Onni and Michael completed several 5K running events.

"One day I asked her if she'd like to do a triathlon, and she grinned from ear to ear," Michael recalls.

Michael emailed Team Hoyt, the world-famous father-and-son triathlon duo, inquiring as to what equipment the two use for the swim portion of their events.

"Team Hoyt not only provided some valuable information regarding the boat and tow rope, but they put us in touch with Jeanna Mogauro," says Michael. Mogauro is the president of the Western New York chapter of Team Hoyt sister organization "Ainsley's Angels" (www.ainsleysangels.org), a sister organization to Team Hoyt. Ainsley's Angels pairs teams like Michael and Onni, and Mogauro gave them tips and encouragement.

Onni and Michael practiced their swiming in the Perinton Recreation pools and Canandaigua Lake while family friend Marie Boudreau-Ninkov took Onni on training runs. When they were ready, Michael and Onni signed up to complete their first-ever triathlon, the 2015 mini-Mussel.

"Michael and Onni did the race with very little fanfare," remembers Musselman Triathlon race director Rich Clark. "It was just two triathletes out on the course - but all weekend long, people were buzzing about how inspiring the sight of these two was."

"Rich Clark and the entire Score-This!!! staff were very accommodating, very welcoming," says Michael. "Onni had a great time at the event. Everyone who saw Onni on the course said they knew she was having a great time by the huge smile on her face!"
